The School:

Hill Country is a Pre-K through 12 Christ-centered, classical, college preparatory school.
Accreditations: Southern Association of Colleges and Schools; Southern Association of Independent Schools; Association of Christian Schools International.

Enrollment:

Class of 2012: 17 students; grades Pre-K-12: 490 students.

Curricular Distinctives:

Hill Country's rigorous curriculum includes the classical components of two semesters of Logic, a minimum of Latin I & II, a junior-level thesis project, Senior Rhetoric including a senior-level thesis presentation and the History of Western Thought, the senior-level history and philosophy course.

Ranking/GPA:

Hill Country Christian School does not rank its students except for the top two students in order to designate Valedictorian and Salutatorian. The grade point average is computed on a weighted 4-point scale with the following numerical equivalents: A = 90-100; B = 80-89; C = 70-79; F = 69 or below. The Class of 2012 GPA distribution:
